Many of my friends know about the work I do delivering gifts as Santa Claus for the Opelousas Area Cerebral Palsy Clinic. It is the most inspiring and important charity that I am involved with. The Clinic has been open since 1955 (over 54 years!) and provides physical therapy treatments that are necessary for area children and adults, **free of charge**.



Nearly every single expense for the Clinic is paid for by the contributions from individuals like you, local companies, and The St. Landry-Evangeline United Way. Because all of the food and expenses related to the breakfast are donated, 100% of your donation goes directly to helping the special needs for the kids and adults. Our first year, your donations totaled \$22,500. Our second year, we reached \$35,000. Our third year, we reached \$41,725. Our fourth, with the extra special help of Valero, we reached **\$83,218!!!** And last

year, \$42,113. This year, our sixth annual, we want our donation to be extra special and I need your help. **If we can reach \$50,000 or more, I will once again personally donate an additional \$5,000.**
