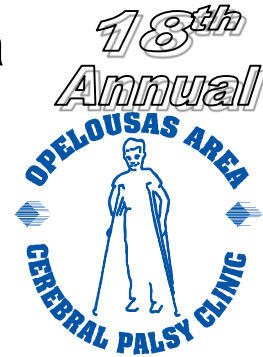

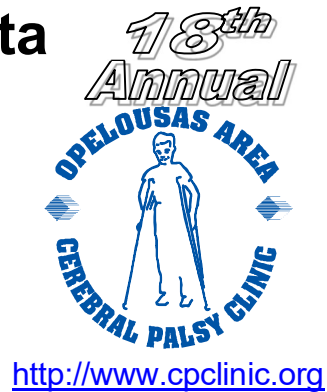

Special Instructions for the COVID Virus Breakfast with Santa



Due to the novel coronavirus, this year's event will follow last year's protocols.

- 1) **Location:** This year's event will be at the Opelousas CivicCenter at 1638 Creswell Ln, Opelousas, LA 70570
- 2) **DO NOT ENTER FROM CRESWELL LANE EXTENSION!** Use I-49 Exit 17/Judson Walsh and take the service road north. Enter the Opelousas Civic Center parking lot next to Hancock/Whitney Bank. Opelousas Police will be there to guide you. There will be a drive-up lane as well as parking available.
- 3) All food will be prepared in TO GO plates with disposable utensils and condiments. We will have a drive-up service so you do not have to exit your car. We are encouraging you, when you fill out your RSVP form, drive-up may be easier and safer. Do allow time for a wait because there may be a line.
- 4) We will serve a limited amount of people inside the building. If we are at capacity inside, we will have to ask that you take your plate to go. First come, first served. Anyone entering the building will be required to **wear a mask** following the directives of the Center for Disease Control as well as the mask mandate by Mayor Alsandor with the City of Opelousas. The building will be cleaned before and after the event by virus cleaning experts.
